- 7 (b) The panel shall prepare separate lists of those medical 8 treatments and surgical procedures that do and do not require 9 disclosure and, for those treatments and procedures that do require 10 disclosure, shall establish the degree of disclosure required and 11 the form in which the disclosure will be made. Each provision of a 12 disclosure form prepared under this subsection must be made
- SECTION 2. (a) The Texas Medical Disclosure Panel shall provide new forms and revise existing forms according to the requirements of Subsection (b), Section 74.103, Civil Practice and Remedies Code, as amended by this Act, not later than January 1, 2006.
- 19 (b) This Act applies only to those medical treatments and 20 surgical procedures determined by the Texas Medical Disclosure 21 Panel to require disclosure of the risks and hazards to the patient, 22 or a person authorized to consent for the patient, that are 23 performed at least 90 days after the date the notice of the adoption 24 of the form required to be distributed under Subsection (b),
