1-8 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED  
1-9 AN ACT

1-10 relating to the hours of sale and consumption of wine at a winery.

1-11 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-12 SECTION 1. Subsection (a), Section 105.01, Alcoholic  
1-13 Beverage Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-14 (a) Except as provided in Sections 105.02, 105.03, ~~[and]~~  
1-15 105.04, and 105.08 ~~[of this code]~~, no person may sell, offer for  
1-16 sale, or deliver any liquor:

1-17 (1) on New Year's Day, Thanksgiving Day, or Christmas  
1-18 Day;

1-19 (2) on Sunday; or

1-20 (3) before 10 a.m. or after 9 p.m. on any other day.

1-21 SECTION 2. Chapter 105, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is amended  
1-22 by adding Section 105.08 to read as follows:

1-23 Sec. 105.08. HOURS OF SALE AND CONSUMPTION: WINERY. The  
1-24 holder of a winery permit may sell, offer for sale, and deliver  
1-25 wine, and a person may consume wine on the premises of a winery:

1-26 (1) between 8 a.m. and midnight on any day except  
1-27 Sunday; and

1-28 (2) between 10 a.m. and midnight on Sunday.

1-29 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-30 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-31 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-32 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-33 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
