- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subsection (c), Section 223.0041,
- 6 Transportation Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (c) For a maintenance contract involving an amount less than
- \$ \$300,000 [\$100,000], if the lowest bidder withdraws its bid prior
- 9 to contract award or fails to execute the contract, the director may
- 10 recommend to the commission that the contract be awarded to the
- 11 second lowest bidder. The commission may award the maintenance
- 12 contract to the second lowest bidder if the second lowest bidder
- 13 agrees to accept the unit bid prices of the lowest bidder. The
- 14 commission shall adopt rules governing the conditions under which
- 15 the department will allow the withdrawal of the bid of the lowest
- 16 bidder and consider awarding a maintenance contract to the second
- 17 lowest bidder.
- 18 SECTION 2. (a) The changes in law made by this Act to the
- 19 Texas Department of Transportation's contract procedures apply
- 20 only to a highway project for which the department first solicits
- 21 bids on or after September 1, 2005.
- (b) A highway project for which the Texas Department of
- 23 Transportation first solicited bids before September 1, 2005, is
- governed by the law as it existed immediately before the effective

- 1 date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect for that
- 2 purpose.
- 3 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
