## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the authority of a political subdivision to require a
3	building permit for construction and renovation work on
4	county-owned buildings and facilities.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Chapter 245, Local Government Code, is amended
7	by adding Section 245.0051 to read as follows:
8	Sec. 245.0051. CONSTRUCTION AND RENOVATION WORK ON
9	COUNTY-OWNED BUILDINGS OR FACILITIES IN CERTAIN COUNTIES.
10	(a) This section applies only to a county with a population of 3.2
11	million or more.
12	(b) A political subdivision is not authorized to require a
13	county to notify the political subdivision or obtain a permit for
14	any new construction or renovation work performed within the limits
15	of the political subdivision by the county on county-owned
16	buildings or facilities if such construction or renovation work is
17	overseen and inspected by a registered professional engineer or
18	architect licensed in this state.
19	(c) This section does not exempt a county from complying
20	with a political subdivision's standards when performing
21	construction or renovation work.
22	SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
23	a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
