1-10 A BILL TO BE ENTITLED
1-11 AN ACT

1-12 relating to certificates of veterinary inspection.

1-13 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-14 SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 161, Agriculture Code, is
1-15 amended by adding Section 161.0601 to read as follows:

1-16 Sec. 161.0601. CERTIFICATES OF VETERINARY INSPECTION.

1-17 (a) The commission by rule may provide for the issuance of a
1-18 certificate of veterinary inspection by a veterinarian to a person
1-19 transporting livestock, exotic livestock, domestic fowl, or exotic
1-20 fowl.

1-21 (b) The commission by rule shall set and charge a fee for
1-22 each certificate of veterinary inspection provided to a
1-23 veterinarian under this section.

1-24 SECTION 2. Subsection (d), Section 161.081, Agriculture
1-25 Code, is repealed.

1-26 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
