- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 2, Article 17.151, Code of Criminal
- 6 Procedure, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 2. The provisions of this article do not apply to a
- 8 defendant who is:
- 9 (1) serving a sentence of imprisonment for another
- 10 offense while the defendant [he] is serving that sentence;
- 11 (2) being detained pending trial of another accusation
- 12 against the defendant [him] as to which the applicable period has
- 13 not yet elapsed; [or]
- 14 (3) incompetent to stand trial, during the period of
- 15 the defendant's [his] incompetence; or
- 16 (4) being detained for a violation of the conditions
- of a previous release related to the safety of a victim of the
- 18 alleged offense or to the safety of the community under this
- 19 <u>article</u>.
- 20 SECTION 2. Section 3, Article 17.151, Code of Criminal
- 21 Procedure, is repealed.
- 22 SECTION 3. This Act applies only to a person who is arrested
- on or after the effective date of this Act, regardless of when the
- 24 offense giving rise to the arrest was committed. A person who is

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- 1 arrested before the effective date of this Act is governed by the
- $2\,$ $\,$ law in effect at the time of the arrest, and the former law is
- 3 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
