1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the territory of certain 9-1-1 emergency communication
1-9 districts.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. Section 772.105, Health and Safety Code, is
1-12 amended by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:

1-13 (c) A public agency located wholly or partly in a county
1-14 adjoining the county for which the district is created and that has
1-15 received 9-1-1 service through a regional planning commission
1-16 interlocal agreement with the district for at least 10 years may
1-17 become part of the district by resolution of the agency's governing
1-18 body and approval by the board.

1-19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
