SECTION 3. A rule adopted under Subsection (a), Section 33.0812, Education Code, as added by this Act, does not apply to student participation in a University Interscholastic League area, regional, or state competition for which a contract for the provision of facilities in which the competition will be conducted was entered into before the effective date of this Act.

SECTION 4. This Act applies beginning with the 2006-2007 school year.

SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
