A BILL TO BE ENTITLED 1 AN ACT 2 relating to photograph and live lineup identification procedures in 3 criminal cases. BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4 SECTION 1. Chapter 38, Code of Criminal Procedure, 5 is 6 amended by adding Article 38.20 to read as follows: Art. 38.20. PHOTOGRAPH AND LIVE LINEUP IDENTIFICATION 7 PROCEDURES. (a) A person administering a photograph or live lineup 8 identification procedure to enable a witness to identify an 9 offender for purposes of prosecution in a criminal case shall show 10 the photographs or live lineup participants sequentially to the 11 12 witness. The person shall require the witness to state whether the individual shown is the offender before the witness views the next 13 14 photograph or live lineup participant. (b) Before a photograph or live lineup identification 15 16 procedure, the person administering the procedure shall inform the 17 witness that: 18 (1) the offender may not be among those shown, and the witness is not required to make an identification; 19 (2) the witness will be shown photographs or live 20 21 lineup participants one at a time and will be required to state whether the individual shown is the offender before the witness 22 23 views the next photograph or live lineup participant; and 24 (3) the witness should not assume that the person

1	administering the photograph or live lineup identification
2	procedure knows which individual is the suspect in the case.
3	(c) A witness who views a live lineup or photograph array
4	must sign a form stating that the witness has received the
5	information described by Subsection (b).
6	(d) If the witness identifies an individual as the offender,
7	the person administering the photograph or live lineup
8	identification procedure shall require the witness to characterize
9	the degree of certainty of the witness that the individual
10	identified is the offender.
11	(e) Only one member of a photograph array or live lineup may
12	be a suspect in the case. The remaining members must be individuals
13	who are not suspects but who satisfy the witness's previous
14	description of the offender without appearing to be significantly
15	different from the suspect. Five or more individuals who are not
16	suspects must be included in the photograph array or live lineup.
17	(f) The person who administers a photograph or live lineup
18	identification procedure may not be made aware of which member of
19	the photograph array or live lineup is the suspect in the case.
20	(g) Information related to a photograph or live lineup
21	identification procedure must be documented in writing, including:
22	(1) identification information regarding the
23	photographs or live lineup participants and sources of any
24	photographs used;
25	(2) names of all individuals present when the
26	procedure was conducted; and
27	(3) the date and time the procedure was conducted.

1	(h) A live lineup identification procedure must be
2	photographed or videotaped. The photographs or video from the
3	procedure must be disclosed to the defendant and the attorney
4	representing the defendant during discovery proceedings in the
5	case.
6	SECTION 2. Article 38.20, Code of Criminal Procedure, as
7	added by this Act, applies to any photograph or live lineup
8	identification procedure that is conducted on or after the
9	effective date of this Act.

10 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
