13 (2) the rate for any subdivisions within that county is not

14 greater than 15 percent higher than the rate used in any other

subdivisions in the county by that insurer[, except that the

16 commissioner may by rule allow a greater rate difference for

17 residential property insurance or personal automobile insurance].

18 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to the rates applicable to

19 insurance policies that are delivered, issued for delivery, or

renewed on or after January 1, 2006. Rates applicable to policies

21 that are delivered, issued for delivery, or renewed before January

22 1, 2006, are governed by the law as it existed immediately before

the effective date of this Act, and that law is continued in effect

24 for this purpose.
