- that is punishable as provided by Section 7.156 for an offense under

- 12 (c) A person who sells a regulated substance to a common
- 13 carrier who delivers the regulated substance to the owner or
- 14 operator of an underground storage tank into which the regulated
- 15 substance is deposited, and who does not deliver the regulated
- 16 substance into the underground storage tank, and the common carrier
- 17 who delivers the regulated substance to the owner or operator of an
- 18 underground storage tank into which the regulated substance is
- 19 <u>deposited</u>, are [is] not liable under this chapter with respect to

- 21 SECTION 2. (a) The change in law made by this Act applies
- 22 only to an offense committed on or after the effective date of this

- 2 (b) An offense committed before the effective date of this
- 3 Act is covered by the law in effect when the offense was committed,
- 4 and the former law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- 5 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
