## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the regulation of air conditioning and refrigeration
3	technicians.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 1302.002, Occupations Code, is amended
6	by adding Subdivisions (5-a) and (17) to read as follows:

- 7 (5-a) "Air conditioning and refrigeration technician"

  8 means a person who assists a licensed air conditioning and

  9 refrigeration contractor in performing air conditioning and

  10 refrigeration maintenance work.
- 11 (17) "Registered technician" means a technician who is
  12 registered with the department.
- SECTION 2. Chapter 1302, Occupations Code, is amended by adding Subchapter K to read as follows:
- 15 SUBCHAPTER K. AIR CONDITIONING AND REFRIGERATION TECHNICIANS
- Sec. 1302.501. REGISTRATION REQUIRED. (a) A person may not act as an air conditioning and refrigeration technician unless the person holds a certificate of registration issued under this
- 20 (b) A certificate is valid throughout the state.
- Sec. 1302.502. RULES. The executive director shall adopt

- (1) registering technicians as prescribed by this

7	Sec. 1302.503. SUPERVISION REQUIREMENTS FOR REGISTRANTS.
8	(a) An air conditioning and refrigeration technician must be
9	supervised by an air conditioning and refrigeration contractor
10	licensed under this chapter.
11	(b) A certificate holder shall notify the department in
12	writing not later than the 30th day after the date on which a change
13	occurs in the identity of an air conditioning and refrigeration
14	contractor who supervises the certificate holder.
15	Sec. 1302.504. APPLICATION; FEE. (a) An applicant for a
16	certificate must submit an application on a form prescribed by the
17	executive director.
18	(b) The completed application must be accompanied by:
19	(1) the application fee; and
20	(2) the name and license number of each air
21	conditioning and refrigeration contractor who will supervise the
22	applicant.
23	(c) The department may examine any criminal conviction,
24	guilty plea, or deferred adjudication of an applicant, including
25	obtaining any criminal history record information permitted by law.
26	Sec. 1302.505. ISSUANCE AND TERM OF REGISTRATION. (a) Or

receipt of a completed application, the department shall issue a

- 1 certificate to an applicant who meets the requirements of this
- 2 <u>subchapter</u>.
- 3 (b) A certificate is valid for one year from the date of
- 4 issuance.
- 5 Sec. 1302.506. RENEWAL OF REGISTRATION. To renew a
- 6 <u>certificate a certificate holder must:</u>
- 7 (1) submit a renewal request on a form prescribed by
- 8 the executive director;
- 9 (2) provide the name and license number of each air
- 10 conditioning and refrigeration contractor who will supervise the
- 11 <u>certificate holder; and</u>
- 12 (3) pay the required renewal fee.
- SECTION 3. Not later than December 31, 2005, the executive
- 14 director of the Texas Department of Licensing and Regulation shall
- adopt rules implementing Subchapter K, Chapter 1302, Occupations
- 16 Code, as added by this Act.
- 17 SECTION 4. (a) Except as provided by Subsection (b) of this
- 18 section, this Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
- 19 (b) Sections 1302.501 and 1302.503, Occupations Code, as
- 20 added by this Act, take effect June 30, 2006.
