A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to testing and examination fee requirements for certain
3	provisional license holders.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Section 521.273, Transportation Code, is amended
6	by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
7	(c) The department shall require a provisional license
8	holder to pass the examination under Section 521.161(b)(2) before
9	issuing a renewal driver's license to the holder if, in the year
10	preceding the date of renewal of the license, the license holder:
11	(1) has been convicted of a moving violation; or
12	(2) has had the holder's license suspended, due to one
13	or more incidents involving the operation of a motor vehicle, by the
14	department.
15	SECTION 2. Section 521.421, Transportation Code, is amended
16	by adding Subsections (i) and (j) to read as follows:
17	(i) In addition to the fee in Subsection (c), an applicant
18	applying for a renewal or reinstatement of a provisional license
19	must pay a \$10 examination fee if the applicant takes the
20	examination required by Section 521.161(b)(2).
21	(j) The fee collected under Subsection (i) must be deposited
22	to the credit of a special account in the general revenue fund and
23	may be used only by the department for the administration of this
24	chapter.

1 SECTION 3. This Act applies only to an application for the 2 renewal or reinstatement of a provisional driver's license 3 submitted on or after the effective date of this Act.

4 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
