(a) In addition to the other authority granted by this 9 subchapter, the board of regents of the University of North Texas 10 System may acquire, purchase, construct, improve, renovate, 11 12 enlarge, or equip property, buildings, structures, or other facilities, including roads and related infrastructure, for the 13 University of North Texas, for the University of North Texas System 14 Center at Dallas at the location to become the University of North 15 Texas at Dallas, or for the Universities Center at Dallas, to be 16 financed by the issuance of bonds in accordance with this 17 18 subchapter, including bonds issued in accordance with a systemwide revenue financing program and secured as provided by that program, 19 in aggregate principal amounts not to exceed: 20 21 (1) 94 million for the University of North Texas; 22 (2) \$30 million for the University of North Texas

(3) \$10 million for the Universities Center at Dallas.

1 (b) The board of regents may pledge irrevocably to the 2 payment of the bonds authorized by this section all or any part of 3 the revenue funds of an institution, branch, or entity of the 4 University of North Texas System, including student tuition 5 charges. The amount of a pledge made under this subsection may not 6 be reduced or abrogated while the bonds for which the pledge is 7 made, or bonds issued to refund those bonds, are outstanding.

8 (c) If sufficient funds are not available to the board of 9 regents to meet its obligations under this section, the board may 10 transfer funds among institutions, branches, and entities of the 11 University of North Texas System to ensure the most equitable and 12 efficient allocation of available resources for each institution, 13 branch, or entity to carry out its duties and purposes.

14 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 15 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 16 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 17 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 18 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
