## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

AN ACT

- 2 relating to the authority of a dental hygienist to administer
- 3 fluoride varnish.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 262.152, Occupations Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 262.152. PERFORMANCE OF DELEGATED DUTIES. Except as
- 8 provided by Section 262.153, a [A] dental hygienist shall practice
- 9 dental hygiene:
- 10 (1) in the dental office of a supervising dentist
- 11 licensed by the board; or
- 12 (2) in an alternate setting, including a nursing home,
- 13 the patient's home, a school, a hospital, a state institution, a
- 14 public health clinic, or another institution, under the supervision
- of a supervising dentist.
- SECTION 2. Subchapter D, Chapter 262, Occupations Code, is
- amended by adding Section 262.153 to read as follows:
- 18 Sec. 262.153. LIMITED FLUORIDE VARNISH PERMIT. (a) The
- 19 board by rule shall provide for issuance of a permit to a dental
- 20 hygienist to administer fluoride varnish.
- 21 (b) To obtain a permit under this section, a dental
- 22 hygienist must meet the educational qualifications and provide
- 23 proof of competency in the administration of fluoride varnish as
- 24 required by the board after consultation with the advisory

- 1 committee.
- 2 <u>(c)</u> Rules adopted by the board under this section must
- 3 include rules that regulate the administration of fluoride varnish
- 4 by a dental hygienist who holds a permit under this section.
- 5 (d) A dental hygienist with a permit issued under this
- 6 section may administer fluoride varnish without supervision by a
- 7 dentist.
- 8 SECTION 3. The State Board of Dental Examiners shall adopt
- 9 rules as required by Section 262.153, Occupations Code, as added by
- this Act, not later than November 1, 2005.
- 11 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
