## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

- 2 relating to the authority of a dental hygienist to prescribe and
- administer fluoride varnish. 3
- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 4
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 258.001, Occupations Code, is amended to
- 6 read as follows:
- Sec. 258.001. IMPERMISSIBLE DELEGATIONS. A dentist may 7
- not delegate: 8
- an act to an individual who, by board order, is 9 (1)
- prohibited from performing the act; 10
- any of the following acts to a person not licensed 11
- 12 as a dentist or dental hygienist:
- 13 (A) the removal of calculus, deposits,
- accretions from the natural and restored surfaces of exposed human 14
- teeth and restorations in the human mouth; 15
- root planing or the smoothing and polishing 16
- of roughened root surfaces or exposed human teeth; or 17
- 18 (C) any other act the delegation of which is
- prohibited by board rule; 19
- any of the following acts to a person not licensed 20
- 21 as a dentist:
- 22 (A) comprehensive examination or diagnosis and
- treatment planning; 23
- a surgical or cutting procedure on hard or 24 (B)

- 1 soft tissue;
- 2 (C) except as provided by Section 262.153, the
- 3 prescription of a drug, medication, or work authorization;
- 4 (D) the taking of an impression for a final
- 5 restoration, appliance, or prosthesis;
- 6 (E) the making of an intraoral occlusal
- 7 adjustment;
- 8 (F) direct pulp capping, pulpotomy, or any other
- 9 endodontic procedure;
- 10 (G) the final placement and intraoral adjustment
- of a fixed or removable appliance; or
- 12 (H) the placement of any final restoration; or
- 13 (4) the authority to an individual to administer a
- 14 local anesthetic agent, inhalation sedative agent, parenteral
- 15 sedative agent, or general anesthetic agent if the individual is
- 16 not licensed as:
- 17 (A) a dentist with a permit issued by the board
- 18 for the procedure being performed, if a permit is required;
- 19 (B) a certified registered nurse anesthetist
- 20 licensed by the Board of Nurse Examiners, only if the delegating
- 21 dentist holds a permit issued by the board for the procedure being
- 22 performed, if a permit is required; or
- 23 (C) a physician anesthesiologist licensed by the
- 24 Texas State Board of Medical Examiners.
- 25 SECTION 2. Section 262.151(a), Occupations Code, is amended
- 26 to read as follows:
- 27 (a) A licensed dentist may delegate orally or in writing a

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- 1 service, task, or procedure to a dental hygienist who is under the
- 2 supervision and responsibility of the dentist, if:
- 3 (1) the dental hygienist is licensed to perform the
- 4 service, task, or procedure;
- 5 (2) the supervising dentist examines the patient:
- 6 (A) at the time the service, task, or procedure
- 7 is performed by the dental hygienist; or
- 8 (B) during the 12 calendar months preceding the
- 9 date of performance of the service, task, or procedure by the dental
- 10 hygienist; and
- 11 (3) the dental hygienist does not:
- 12 (A) diagnose a dental disease or ailment;
- 13 (B) prescribe a treatment or a regimen;
- 14 (C) except as provided by Section 262.153,
- 15 prescribe, order, or dispense medication; or
- 16 (D) perform any procedure that is irreversible or
- 17 involves the intentional cutting of soft or hard tissue by any
- 18 means.
- 19 SECTION 3. Section 262.152, Occupations Code, is amended to
- 20 read as follows:
- Sec. 262.152. PERFORMANCE OF DELEGATED DUTIES. <u>Except as</u>
- 22 provided by Section 262.153, a [A] dental hygienist shall practice
- 23 dental hygiene:
- 24 (1) in the dental office of a supervising dentist
- 25 licensed by the board; or
- 26 (2) in an alternate setting, including a nursing home,
- 27 the patient's home, a school, a hospital, a state institution, a

- 1 public health clinic, or another institution, under the supervision
- 2 of a supervising dentist.
- 3 SECTION 4. Subchapter D, Chapter 262, Occupations Code, is
- 4 amended by adding Section 262.153 to read as follows:
- 5 Sec. 262.153. LIMITED PRESCRIPTION PERMIT. (a) The board
- 6 by rule shall provide for issuance of a permit to a dental hygienist
- 7 <u>to prescribe and administer fluoride varnish.</u>
- 8 (b) To obtain a permit under this section, a dental
- 9 hygienist must meet the educational qualifications and provide
- 10 proof of competency in the administration of fluoride varnish as
- 11 required by the board after consultation with the advisory
- committee.
- 13 (c) Rules adopted by the board under this section must
- 14 include rules that regulate the administration of fluoride varnish
- by a dental hygienist who holds a permit under this section.
- 16 (d) A dental hygienist with a permit issued under this
- 17 section may prescribe and administer fluoride varnish without
- 18 supervision by a dentist.
- 19 SECTION 5. The State Board of Dental Examiners shall adopt
- 20 rules as required by Section 262.153, Occupations Code, as added by
- this Act, not later than November 1, 2005.
- 22 SECTION 6. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
