## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

L	AN ACT

- 2 relating to the liability of a social host for providing alcohol to
- 3 a minor.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 2.01, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Subdivision (3) to read as follows:
- 7 (3) "Social host" means a person, other than a person
- 8 <u>described by Subdivision (1), who, on premises owned by the person</u>
- 9 or at which the person resides, provides or serves an alcoholic
- 10 beverage to an individual.
- 11 SECTION 2. Section 2.02, Alcoholic Beverage Code, is
- 12 amended by adding Subsection (c) to read as follows:
- (c) The provision or service of an alcoholic beverage by a
- 14 social host to an individual under 18 years of age may be made the
- 15 basis of a statutory cause of action under this chapter on proof
- 16 that:
- 17 (1) at the time the provision or service of the
- 18 alcoholic beverage occurred it was apparent to the social host that
- 19 the recipient of the beverage was obviously intoxicated to the
- 20 <u>extent that the recipient presented a clear danger to the recipient</u>
- 21 and others; and
- 22 (2) the intoxication of the recipient was a proximate
- 23 cause of the damages suffered.
- SECTION 3. Sections 2.03(a) and (b), Alcoholic Beverage

- 1 Code, are amended to read as follows:
- 2 (a) The liability of providers <u>and social hosts</u> under this
- 3 chapter for the actions of their employees, customers, members, or
- 4 quests who are or become intoxicated is in lieu of common law or
- 5 other statutory law warranties and duties of providers of alcoholic
- 6 beverages and social hosts.
- 7 (b) This chapter does not impose obligations on a provider
- 8 of alcoholic beverages <u>or social host</u> other than those expressly
- 9 stated in this chapter.
- 10 SECTION 4. The change in law made by this Act applies only
- 11 to a cause of action that accrues on or after the effective date of
- 12 this Act. A cause of action that accrues before the effective date
- of this Act is governed by the law in effect immediately before that
- 14 date, and that law is continued in effect for that purpose.
- SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
