AN ACT 1 2 relating to the classification of open-space land into categories 3 for purposes of appraising the land for ad valorem tax purposes. Δ BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Subdivision (3), Section 23.51, Tax Code, 5 is 6 amended to read as follows: "Category" means the value classification of land 7 (3) considering the agricultural use to which the land is principally 8 The chief appraiser shall determine the categories into 9 devoted. which land in the appraisal district is classified. In classifying 10 land according to categories, the chief appraiser shall distinguish 11 between [Categories of land may include but are not limited to] 12 13 irrigated cropland, dry cropland, improved pasture, native pasture, orchard, and waste. The chief appraiser may establish 14 additional categories. The chief appraiser shall [and may be] 15 further divide each category [divided] according to soil type, soil 16 capability, irrigation, general topography, geographical factors, 17 and other factors that [which] influence the productive capacity of 18 the category. The chief appraiser shall obtain information from 19 the Texas Agricultural [Agriculture] Extension Service, the 20 Natural Resources [Soil] Conservation Service of the United States 21 22 Department of Agriculture, and other recognized agricultural 23 sources for the purposes of determining the categories of land 24 [production] existing in the appraisal district.

1 SECTION 2. This Act applies only to the appraisal of 2 open-space land for ad valorem tax purposes for a tax year beginning 3 on or after the effective date of this Act.

4 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect January 1, 2006.
