The change in law made by this Act applies to eligibility for unemployment compensation benefits based on an 1-22 unemployment compensation claim that is filed with the Texas 1-23 Workforce Commission on or after the effective date of this Act. A 1-24 1-25 claim filed before the effective date of this Act is governed by the law in effect on the date the claim was filed, and the former law is 1-26 1-27 continued in effect for that purpose. 1-28 SECTION 3.
