- 5 SECTION 1. Section 208.002, Labor Code, is amended to read
- 6 as follows:
- 7 Sec. 208.002. [NOTICE OF] INITIAL CLAIM; LAST WORK. (a)
- 8 When used in connection with an initial claim, "last work" and
- 9 "person for whom the claimant last worked" refer to:
- 10 (1) the last person for whom the claimant actually
- 11 worked, if the claimant worked for that person in six or more
- 12 consecutive weeks and was paid wages by that person equal to at
- 13 <u>least six times the claimant's weekly benefit amount; or</u>
- 14 (2) the employer, as defined by Subchapter C, Chapter
- 15 201, or by the unemployment law of any other state, for whom the
- 16 claimant last worked.
- 17 (b) The commission shall mail a notice of the filing of an
- initial claim to the person for whom the claimant last worked before
- 19 the effective date of the initial claim. If the person for whom the
- 20 claimant last worked has more than one branch or division operating
- 21 at different locations, the commission shall mail the notice to the
- 22 branch or division at which the claimant last worked.
- (c) $[\frac{b}{b}]$ Mailing of a notice under this section to the

- 1 claimant last worked constitutes notice of the claim to the person.
- 2 SECTION 2. The changes in law made by this Act apply only to
- 3 a claim for unemployment compensation benefits that is filed with
- 4 the Texas Workforce Commission on or after the effective date of
- 5 this Act. A claim filed before that date is governed by the law in
- 6 effect on the date the claim was filed, and the former law is
- 7 continued in effect for that purpose.
- 8 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
