- BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: 5
- 6 SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 55, Education Code, is
- amended by adding Section 55.1757 to read as follows: 7
- Sec. 55.1757. MIDWESTERN STATE UNIVERSITY; ADDITIONAL 8
- 9 BONDS. (a) In addition to the other authority granted by this
- subchapter, the board of regents of Midwestern State University may 10
- 11 issue bonds in accordance with this subchapter in the aggregate
- 12 principal amount not to exceed \$10,395,000 to finance utility
- infrastructure and campus renovations at Midwestern State 13
- 14 University.
- (b) The board may pledge irrevocably to the payment of those 15
- bonds all or any part of the revenue funds of Midwestern State 16
- University, including student tuition charges. The amount of a 17
- 18 pledge made under this subsection may not be reduced or abrogated
- while the bonds for which the pledge is made, or bonds issued to 19
- refund those bonds, are outstanding. 20
- 21 SECTION 2. Section 61.0572(e), Education Code, is amended
- to read as follows: 22
- (e) Approval of the board is not required to acquire real 23
- 24 property that is financed by bonds issued under Section 55.17(e)(3)

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- or (4), 55.1713-55.1718, 55.1721-55.1728, 55.1735(a)(1), 55.174,
- 2 55.1742, 55.1743, [or 55.1744, or 55.1757, except that the board
- 3 shall review all real property to be financed by bonds issued under
- 4 those sections to determine whether the property meets the
- 5 standards adopted by the board for cost, efficiency, and space use.
- 6 If the property does not meet those standards, the board shall
- 7 notify the governor, the lieutenant governor, the speaker of the
- 8 house of representatives, and the Legislative Budget Board.
- 9 SECTION 3. Section 61.058(b), Education Code, is amended to
- 10 read as follows:
- 11 (b) This section does not apply to construction, repair, or
- rehabilitation financed by bonds issued under Section 55.17(e)(3)
- 13 or (4), 55.1713-55.1718, 55.1721-55.1728, 55.174, 55.1742,
- 14 55.1743, [or] 55.1744, or 55.1757, except that the board shall
- 15 review all construction, repair, or rehabilitation to be financed
- 16 by bonds issued under those sections to determine whether the
- 17 construction, rehabilitation, or repair meets the standards
- 18 adopted by board rule for cost, efficiency, and space use. If the
- 19 construction, rehabilitation, or repair does not meet those
- 20 standards, the board shall notify the governor, the lieutenant
- 21 governor, the speaker of the house of representatives, and the
- 22 Legislative Budget Board.
- 23 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 25 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 26 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 27 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
