## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to creation of an inflation adjustment to salaries for
3	classroom teachers and certain other professional staff employed by
4	school districts.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Section 21.402, Education Code, is amended by
7	amending Subsections (a), (c), and (d) and adding Subsections
8	(c-1)-(c-3) and (i) to read as follows:
9	(a) Except as provided by Subsection (d) $[\frac{1}{1},\frac{1}{1}]$ or (f), a
10	school district must pay each classroom teacher, full-time
11	librarian, full-time counselor certified under Subchapter B, or
12	full-time school nurse not less than the minimum monthly salary,
13	based on the employee's level of experience, prescribed by
14	Subsection (c) and adjusted in accordance with Subsection (c-1)
15	[determined by the following formula:
16	[MS - SF x FS
17	[where:
18	["MS" is the minimum monthly salary;
19	["SF" is the applicable salary factor specified by Subsection
20	(c); and
21	["FS" is the amount, as determined by the commissioner under
22	Subsection (b), of state and local funds per weighted student
23	available to a district eligible to receive state assistance under
24	Section 42.302 with an enrichment tax rate, as defined by Section

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42.302, equal to the maximum rate authorized under Section 42.303, 1 2 except that the amount of state and local funds per weighted student does not include the amount attributable to the increase 3 quaranteed level made by H.B. 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- 2 (c-1) The amounts prescribed by Subsection (c) are adjusted
  3 annually in accordance with this subsection as necessary to reflect
  4 inflation. The commissioner shall determine the amount of the
  5 adjustment for each school year based on the difference, if any,
  6 between the Texas Consumer Price index most recently published by
  7 the comptroller as of May 1 of the calendar year in which the school
  8 year begins and the Texas Consumer Price index most recently
- 10 (c-2) Notwithstanding Subsections (a) and (c-1), for the
  2005-2006 school year, a classroom teacher, full-time librarian,
  12 full-time counselor certified under Subchapter B, or full-time
  13 school nurse is entitled to a monthly salary that is at least equal
  14 to the sum of:
- 15 (1) the monthly salary the employee would have
  16 received for the 2005-2006 school year under the district's salary
  17 schedule for the 2004-2005 school year, if that schedule had been in
  18 effect for the 2005-2006 school year, including any local
  19 supplement and any money representing a career ladder supplement
  20 the employee would have received in the 2005-2006 school year; and
- 21 (2) the amount necessary to reflect inflation, as
  22 determined by the commissioner in the manner provided by Subsection
  23 (c-1).
- 24 (c-3) Subsection (c-2) and this subsection expire September 25 1, 2006.
- 26 (d) A classroom teacher, full-time librarian, full-time 27 counselor certified under Subchapter B, or full-time school nurse

- 1 employed by a school district in the 2005-2006 [2000-2001] school
- 2 year is, as long as the employee is employed by the same district,
- 3 entitled to a salary that is at least equal to the greater of:
- 4 (1) the salary to which the employee is entitled under
- 5 Subsection (c), as adjusted in accordance with Subsection (c-1); or
- 6 (2) the salary that is equal to the sum of:
- 7  $\underline{\text{(A)}}$  the salary the employee received for the
- 8  $\underline{\text{preceding}}$  [ $\frac{2000-2001}{}$ ] school year; and
- 9 (B) the amount necessary to reflect inflation, as
- 10 determined by the commissioner in accordance with Subsection (c-1).
- 11 (i) The commissioner's determination under this section of
- 12 an amount necessary to reflect inflation is final and may not be
- 13 <u>appealed</u>.
- 14 SECTION 2. Section 42.2512, Education Code, is amended by
- 15 adding Subsection (a-1) to read as follows:
- 16 (a-1) In addition to the amount specified by Subsection (a),
- 17 a school district, including a school district that is otherwise
- 18 ineligible for state aid under this chapter, is entitled to state
- 19 aid in an amount equal to the total amount of additional salary the
- 20 district is required to pay under Section 21.402 solely to reflect
- 21 <u>inflation</u>. If necessary to provide sufficient funds for purposes
- of this subsection, the Legislative Budget Board shall propose that
- 23 the appropriate amount of money be transferred to the agency in
- 24 accordance with procedures specified by Chapter 317, Government
- 25 Code.
- SECTION 3. Sections 21.402(b) and (e), Education Code, are
- 27 repealed.

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- SECTION 4. This Act applies beginning with the 2005-2006
- 2 school year.
- 3 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
