# A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the long-range plan for the South Texas Health Care
3	System and the provision of tuberculosis and other health care
4	services in the Lower Rio Grande Valley.
5	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
6	SECTION 1. Sections 1 through 7, Chapter 1106, Acts of the
7	76th Legislature, Regular Session, 1999, are amended to read as
8	follows:
9	Sec. 1. CONSTRUCTION OF NEW PHYSICAL FACILITIES FOR
10	OUTPATIENT HEALTH CARE SERVICES. (a) The [ <del>Texas</del> ] Department of
11	<u>State</u> Health <u>Services</u> shall contract for the construction of <u>at</u>
12	<u>least one</u> [ <del>an initial,</del> ] new physical facility for outpatient health
13	care services, including outpatient tuberculosis services, out of
14	funds appropriated to the department for that purpose.
15	(b) [ <del>The initial physical facility constructed under</del>
16	Subsection (a) of this section must be:
17	[ <del>(1) located at the site of the South Texas Hospital in</del>
18	Harlingen, Texas; or
19	[ <del>(2) colocated with the initial site of the Regional</del>
20	Academic Health Center at a common site in Harlingen, Texas, and
21	adjacent to the center.
22	[ <del>(c) The contract under Subsection (a) of this section for</del>
23	the construction of the initial physical facility in Harlingen,
24	Texas, must specify that the physical facility be designed and

constructed to allow for the provision of all outpatient health
care services, including outpatient tuberculosis services,
provided at the South Texas Hospital on the effective date of this
Act. The facility may be designed and constructed to allow for the
provision of additional outpatient health care services.

6 [(d) If the initial physical facility constructed under 7 Subsection (a) of this section is colocated with the Regional Academic Health Center, the contract under this section must 8 9 specify that, to the maximum extent possible, that facility and the 10 Regional Academic Health Center must be designed and constructed 11 together to realize potential savings in construction costs and long-term maintenance and operations costs by using common central 12 utility plants, cafeterias, laundry facilities, maintenance 13 facilities, and other support facilities. The board of regents of 14 The University of Texas System shall cooperate with the Texas 15 16 Department of Health to coordinate the structure and design of the physical facilities of the facility constructed under Subsection 17 (a) of this section and the Regional Academic Health Center 18 achieve a maximally efficient use of resources. 19

[(e) Out of funds available to the Texas Department of Health for that purpose, the department may contract for the construction of additional physical facilities for outpatient health care services, including outpatient tuberculosis services.] One facility may be located in <u>Hidalgo County</u> [McAllen], Texas, and another facility may be located in <u>Cameron County</u> [Brownsville], Texas.

27 Sec. 2. OUTPATIENT HEALTH CARE SERVICES. (a) On

completion of the [initial] physical facility or facilities [in Harlingen, Texas,] required by Section 1 of this Act, the provision of all outpatient health care services, including outpatient tuberculosis services, provided by the South Texas <u>Health Care</u> <u>System</u> [Hospital on the effective date of this Act] shall be transferred to that facility or those facilities.

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7 (b) The [Texas] Department of <u>State</u> Health <u>Services</u> may 8 contract with one or more public or private health care providers or 9 entities for the management and operation of the physical 10 facilities constructed under Section 1 of this Act and for the 11 provision of outpatient health care services at those facilities.

Sec. 3. INPATIENT HEALTH CARE AND RELATED LABORATORY 12 SERVICES. Out of funds appropriated to the [Texas] Department of 13 State Health Services to provide inpatient health care services, 14 the department shall contract with one or more public or private 15 16 health care providers or entities, including a political 17 subdivision that is located in the Rio Grande Valley region and is 18 responsible for providing health care services to its residents, for the provision of inpatient health care services, including 19 inpatient tuberculosis services, and related laboratory services 20 provided by the South Texas Health Care System [Hospital on the 21 effective date of this Act]. 22

23 Sec. 4. INTERIM RENOVATION OF PHYSICAL FACILITIES OF SOUTH 24 TEXAS <u>HEALTH CARE SYSTEM</u> [HOSPITAL]. Out of funds appropriated to 25 the department for the purpose of this section, the [Texas] 26 Department of <u>State</u> Health <u>Services</u> shall contract for minimally 27 necessary structural and design renovations to the physical

facilities of the South Texas Health Care System [Hospital] 1 2 required for compliance with Texas Accessibility Standards and the federal Americans with Disabilities Act of 1990 (42 U.S.C. Section 3 12101 et seq.), as amended, and for the continued operation of the 4 South Texas Health Care System [Hospital] to provide outpatient 5 6 health care services until construction of the [initial] physical 7 facility or facilities required by Section 1 of this Act [in Harlingen, Texas, ] for the provision of those services 8 is 9 completed.

Sec. 5. FUTURE 10 OF SOUTH TEXAS HEALTH CARE SYSTEM 11 [HOSPITAL]. If the Department of State Health Services does not use the current physical facilities of the South Texas Health Care 12 System upon completion of the physical facility or facilities 13 required by Section 1 of this Act, the department [The Texas Board 14 15 of Health] shall give the [Texas] Department of Aging and 16 Disability Services [Mental Health and Mental Retardation] the first option to lease the current physical facilities of the South 17 Texas Health Care System [Hospital] on completion of construction 18 of the [initial] physical facility or facilities required by 19 Section 1 of this Act for outpatient health care services [in 20 Harlingen, Texas, ] and after contracting providers or entities 21 22 under Section 3 of this Act have begun providing inpatient health care and related laboratory services. If the [Texas] Department of 23 Aging and Disability Services [Mental Health and Mental 24 25 Retardation] does not lease the facilities, the department [Texas Board of Health] shall study and prepare leasing and other options 26 27 for potential future uses of the facilities.

[Sec. 6. CONTINUATION OF SUPPORT SERVICES. (a) If the 1 initial physical facility constructed as required by Section 1 of 2 this Act is colocated with the Regional Academic Health Center, the 3 Texas Department of Health and the Texas Department of Mental 4 5 Health and Mental Retardation shall enter into an interagency 6 contract to provide for the continuation of support services for 7 the facility operated by the Texas Department of Mental Health and Mental Retardation that is colocated with the South Texas Hospital. 8 9 [(b) The contract may include a provision requiring the 10 Texas Department of Health to continue providing employees for

11 support facilities at the site.]

Sec. 7. DISPLACED EMPLOYEES OF SOUTH TEXAS HEALTH CARE 12 SYSTEM [HOSPITAL]. (a) Out of available funds appropriated to 13 the [Texas] Department of State Health Services, the department 14 shall reassign a member of the employee class of the department who 15 16 is employed at the South Texas <u>Health Care System</u> [Hospital] and 17 whose position is displaced as a result of a contract entered into 18 by the [Texas] Department of State Health Services under this Act or the transfer of services from the South Texas Health Care System 19 [Hospital] to an open position within the department in reasonable 20 proximity to the South Texas Health Care System [Hospital] and for 21 22 which the member is qualified. If reassignment of a member of the employee class to another position within the department is not 23 24 possible, the department shall provide job placement assistance to 25 the member.

(b) A contract awarded by the [Texas] Department of <u>State</u>
 Health Services under this Act must include a provision that the

1 contracting entity shall offer an employee of the South Texas 2 <u>Health Care System</u> [Hospital] whose position is displaced as a 3 result of the contract a similar employment position with the 4 contracting entity before offering the position to any other person 5 if the contracting entity determines that the displaced employee is 6 qualified for the position.
