1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the TexasOnline Authority's use of TexasOnline revenue.

1-9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-10 SECTION 1. Subchapter I, Chapter 2054, Government Code, is  
1-11 amended by adding Section 2054.272 to read as follows:

1-12 Sec. 2054.272. USE OF REVENUE FOR PORTALS. The authority  
1-13 may use not more than 50 percent of the state's share of revenue  
1-14 generated by TexasOnline to develop Internet portals that provide  
1-15 access to information regarding:

- 1-16 (1) education;  
1-17 (2) business; and  
1-18 (3) state employees.

1-19 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives  
1-20 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as  
1-21 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this  
1-22 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this  
1-23 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
