  the district's superintendent or the superintendent's designee

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- (1) the organization qualifies for a tax exemption under Section 501(a), Internal Revenue Code of 1986, as an organization described by Section 501(c)(3) of that code;
- 17 (2) the activities are acceptable and beneficial for 18 school-aged children; and
- 19 (3) conducting the activities on district property
  20 will not disrupt district activities.
- 21 <u>(b) A school district may not charge a nonprofit</u>
  22 <u>organization for use of district property to conduct activities</u>
  23 <u>under this section an amount greater than the actual cost to the</u>
