A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to distribution of recordings on consignment.
- 3 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 4 SECTION 1. Section 2101.002, Occupations Code, is amended
- 5 by amending Subdivision (1) and adding Subdivisions (6) and (7) to
- 6 read as follows:
- 7 (1) "Art" means a commonly recognized art form,
- 8 including a painting, sound recording of a musical performance,
- 9 sculpture, drawing, work of graphic art, pottery, weaving, batik,
- 10 macrame, or quilt.
- 11 (6) "Recording distributor" means a person who
- 12 acquires a sound recording and sells the sound recording to another
- person for use or resale.
- 14 (7) "Sound recording" means a tangible medium on which
- 15 music or other sounds are recorded or otherwise stored, including a
- 16 phonograph record, disc, tape, cassette, or other medium now
- 17 existing or developed later on which music or other sounds are or
- 18 can be recorded or otherwise stored or a copy or reproduction that
- 19 <u>duplicates in whole or in part the original</u>. The term does not
- 20 <u>include a medium on which the primary recorded information is</u>
- 21 <u>information other than music or other sound, such as a motion</u>
- 22 picture or computer program, and that contains recorded sound as an
- 23 integrated part of the primary recorded information.
- 24 SECTION 2. Chapter 2101, Occupations Code, is amended by

- 1 adding Section 2101.004 to read as follows:
- 2 Sec. 2101.004. CONSIGNED SOUND RECORDINGS EXEMPT FROM
- 3 CERTAIN LIENS OR CLAIMS. (a) Notwithstanding any provision of the
- 4 Business & Commerce Code, a sound recording delivered by the artist
- 5 who produced the music or other sound on the recording to a
- 6 recording distributor for sale and the proceeds from the recording
- 7 distributor's sale of the sound recording are not subject to a
- 8 claim, lien, or security interest of a creditor of the recording
- 9 distributor.
- 10 (b) Except as provided by Subsection (c), this section
- 11 applies to the proceeds of a sale of a sound recording regardless of
- 12 whether the recording distributor or another person purchased the
- 13 recording.
- 14 (c) This section does not apply to the proceeds of a sale of
- 15 <u>a sound recording if the artist delivered the recording to the</u>
- 16 recording distributor pursuant to a sale for which the artist has
- 17 been paid in full.
- SECTION 3. Section 9.102(a)(20), Business & Commerce Code,
- 19 is amended to read as follows:
- 20 (20) "Consignment" means a transaction, regardless of
- 21 its form, in which a person delivers goods to a merchant for the
- 22 purpose of sale and:
- 23 (A) the merchant:
- (i) deals in goods of that kind under a name
- other than the name of the person making delivery;
- 26 (ii) is not an auctioneer; and
- 27 (iii) is not generally known by its

- 1 creditors to be substantially engaged in selling the goods of
- 2 others;
- 3 (B) with respect to each delivery, the aggregate
- 4 value of the goods is \$1,000 or more at the time of delivery;
- 5 (C) the goods are not consumer goods immediately
- 6 before delivery;
- 7 (D) the transaction does not create a security
- 8 interest that secures an obligation; and
- 9 (E) the transaction does not involve delivery of
- 10 a work of art to an art dealer or delivery of a sound recording to a
- 11 <u>distributor if</u>[, as provided by] Chapter 2101, Occupations Code,
- 12 applies to the delivery.
- SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 14 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 15 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 16 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 17 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
