## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to student representation on the board of regents of each
- 3 state university or state university system.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter G, Chapter 51, Education Code, is
- 6 amended by adding Sections 51.355, 51.356, and 51.357 to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 Sec. 51.355. STUDENT REGENT DESIGNATE; UNIVERSITY SYSTEM
- 9 BOARD OF REGENTS. (a) In this section, "student government" means
- 10 the representative student organization directly elected by the
- 11 student body of a general academic teaching institution.
- (b) Except as provided by Subsection (e), not later than
- 13 <u>September 1 of each year, the student government of each general</u>
- 14 academic teaching institution in a university system shall select
- 15 one graduate student and one undergraduate student of the
- 16 institution to serve as the institution's representatives on the
- 17 university system's student regent nominating committee. As soon
- 18 thereafter as practicable, the student regent nominating committee
- 19 shall solicit applicants from each institution in the system for
- 20 the position of student regent designate. Not later than December
- 21 <u>1, from among the applications received by the student regent</u>
- 22 <u>nominating committee</u>, the committee shall select three applicants
- 23 as the committee's recommendations for the position of student
- 24 regent designate for the university system and shall send the

- 1 applications of those applicants to the system's board of regents.
- 2 From among those applicants, not later than February 1 or as soon
- 3 thereafter as practicable, the university system's board of regents
- 4 shall select an applicant to serve as the student regent designate
- for the system for a one-year term expiring on the next February 1.
- 6 (c) A student regent designate must be enrolled as an
- 7 undergraduate or graduate student in a general academic teaching
- 8 <u>institution in the university system at the time of selection and</u>
- 9 throughout the student regent designate's term. For purposes of
- 10 this subsection, a person is considered to be enrolled in an
- 11 institution for a summer term if the person was enrolled in the
- institution for the preceding semester and:
- 13 (1) is registered or preregistered at the institution
- 14 for the following fall semester;
- 15 (2) if the person has not completed the person's degree
- 16 program, is eligible to continue the degree program at the
- institution in the following fall semester; or
- 18 <u>(3) if the person completed a degree program in the</u>
- 19 preceding semester, is admitted to another degree program at the
- 20 institution for the following fall semester.
- 21 (d) A student regent designate for a university system has
- the same powers and duties as the members of the board of regents of
- 23 the system, except that the student regent designate:
- (1) may not vote on any matter before the board or make
- or second any motion before the board; and
- 26 (2) is not counted in determining whether a quorum
- 27 exists for a meeting of the board or in determining the outcome of

- 1 any vote of the board.
- 2 (e) The student government of the general academic teaching
- 3 institution at which a current student regent designate was
- 4 enrolled at the time of the student regent designate's selection
- 5 may not solicit applicants for the position of student regent
- 6 designate for the next regular term of the position.
- 7 (f) If the current student regent designate for a university
- 8 system is an undergraduate student at the time of the student regent
- 9 designate's selection, the student regent designate selected for
- 10 the next regular term of the position must be a graduate student at
- 11 the time of that student regent designate's selection. If the
- 12 current student regent designate for a university system is a
- 13 graduate student at the time of the student regent designate's
- 14 selection, the student regent designate selected for the next
- 15 regular term of the position must be an undergraduate student at the
- 16 <u>time of the student regent designate's selection.</u>
- 17 (g) A vacancy in the position of student regent designate
- 18 for a university system shall be filled for the unexpired term by
- 19 the board of regents in consultation with the student governments
- of the general academic teaching institutions in the system.
- 21 Sec. 51.356. STUDENT REGENT DESIGNATE; INSTITUTION BOARD OF
- 22 REGENTS. (a) This section applies only to a general academic
- 23 teaching institution that is not a part of a university system.
- 24 (b) In this section, "student government" means the
- 25 representative student organization directly elected by the
- 26 student body of a general academic teaching institution.
- 27 (c) Not later than September 1 of each year, the student

- government of the general academic teaching institution shall 1 2 solicit applicants for the position of student regent designate for the institution. Not later than December 1, from among the 3 4 applications received by the student government, the student government shall select three applicants as the student 5 6 government's recommendations for the position of student regent 7 designate and shall send the applications of those applicants to the institution's board of regents. From among those applicants, 8 9 on February 1 or as soon thereafter as practicable, the board of regents shall select an applicant to serve as the student regent 10 designate for the institution for a one-year term expiring on the 11 12 next February 1.
- 13 (d) A student regent designate must be enrolled as an

  14 undergraduate or graduate student in the general academic teaching

  15 institution at the time of selection and throughout the student

  16 regent designate's term. For purposes of this subsection, a person

  17 is considered to be enrolled in an institution for a summer term if

  18 the person was enrolled in the institution for the preceding

  19 semester and:
- 20 <u>(1) is registered or preregistered at the institution</u> 21 for the following fall semester;
- 22 (2) if the person has not completed the person's degree 23 program, is eligible to continue the degree program at the 24 institution in the following fall semester; or
- 25 (3) if the person completed a degree program in the 26 preceding semester, is admitted to another degree program at the 27 institution for the following fall semester.

- 1 (e) A student regent designate for a general academic
- 2 teaching institution has the same powers and duties as the members
- 3 of the board of regents of the institution, except that the student
- 4 regent designate:
- 5 (1) may not vote on any matter before the board or make
- 6 or second any motion before the board; and
- 7 (2) is not counted in determining whether a quorum
- 8 exists for a meeting of the board or in determining the outcome of
- 9 any vote of the board.
- 10 (f) If the current student regent designate for a general
- 11 academic teaching institution is an undergraduate student at the
- 12 time of the student regent designate's selection, the student
- 13 regent designate selected for the next regular term of the position
- 14 must be a graduate student at the time of that student designate's
- 15 <u>selection</u>. If the current student regent designate for a general
- 16 <u>academic teaching institution is a graduate student at the time of</u>
- 17 the student regent designate's selection, the student regent
- designate selected for the next regular term of the position must be
- 19 an undergraduate student at the time of that student regent
- 20 designate's selection.
- 21 (g) A vacancy in the position of student regent designate
- for a general academic teaching institution shall be filled for the
- 23 unexpired term by the board of regents in consultation with the
- 24 student government of the institution.
- Sec. 51.357. VOTING STUDENT REGENT. (a) On the expiration
- of the term of a student regent designate for a university system
- 27 selected under Section 51.355 or for a general academic teaching

- 1 institution under Section 51.356, the student regent designate
- 2 succeeds to the office of student regent on that board for a term of
- 3 one year.
- 4 (b) A student regent serving under this section has the same
- 5 powers and duties, including voting privileges, as the other
- 6 members of the board on which the student regent serves.
- 7 <u>(c) The enrollment requirements described by Section</u>
- 8 <u>51.355(c)</u> or 51.356(d), as applicable, for a student regent
- 9 designate apply to a student regent serving under this section.
- 10 (d) If a vacancy in the position of student regent occurs,
- the person serving as student regent designate under Section 51.355
- or 51.356, as applicable, shall fill the vacancy for the unexpired
- 13 term. The resulting vacancy in the position of student regent
- 14 designate shall be filled for the unexpired term as provided by
- 15 Section 51.355 or 51.356, as applicable, except that the chancellor
- of the university system or president of the general academic
- 17 teaching institution, as applicable, shall prescribe expedited
- 18 dates to fill the vacancy promptly.
- 19 (e) If the one-year term of the student regent is held by
- 20 final judgment of a court to violate the Texas Constitution, the
- 21 student regent in office at that time holds office for a term of six
- years, and a student regent designate shall be selected only for the
- last year of the six-year term or as necessary to fill a vacancy in
- the office of student regent.
- 25 SECTION 2. Sections 65.11 and 65.12, Education Code, are
- 26 amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 65.11. BOARD OF REGENTS. (a) The government of the

- 1 university system is vested in a board of nine regents. The board
- 2 members other than the student regent are appointed by the governor
- 3 with the advice and consent of the senate.
- 4 (b) One of the board members must be a student regent serving under Section 51.357.
- 6 <u>(c)</u> The board may provide for the administration,
- 7 organization, and names of the institutions and entities in The
- 8 University of Texas System in such a way as will achieve the maximum
- 9 operating efficiency of such institutions and entities, provided,
- 10 however, that no institution or entity of The University of Texas
- 11 System not authorized by specific legislative act to offer a
- 12 four-year undergraduate program as of the effective date of this
- 13 Act shall offer any such four-year undergraduate program without
- 14 prior recommendation and approval by a two-thirds vote of the Texas
- 15 Higher Education Coordinating Board and a specific act of the
- 16 Legislature.
- Sec. 65.12. QUALIFICATIONS; TERMS. (a) Each member of the
- 18 board shall be a qualified voter.
- 19 (b) The board[; and the] members other than the student
- 20 regent shall be selected from different portions of the state.
- 21 <u>(c)</u> The <u>board</u> members <u>other than the student regent</u> hold
- office for staggered terms of six years, with the terms of two or
- three <u>regents</u>, as applicable, expiring February 1 of odd-numbered
- 24 years.
- 25 (d) The student regent holds office for a term of one year
- 26 expiring February 1, with the term of the initial student regent
- 27 expiring February 1, 2008.

- amended by amending Section 95.02 and adding Section 95.022 to read
- 22 as follows:
- Sec. 95.02. BOARD OF REGENTS [MEMBERS: APPOINTMENT,
- 24 QUALIFICATIONS, TERMS]. (a) The board is composed of nine members.
- 25 The board members other than the student regent are appointed by the
- 26 governor with the advice and consent of the senate.
- (b) One of the board members must be a student regent

- 1 <u>serving under Section 51.357</u> [The members hold office for terms of
- 2 six years, with the terms of three members expiring February 1 of
- 3 odd-numbered years. Each member of the board shall be a qualified
- 4 voter; and the members shall be selected from different portions of
- 5 the state].
- 6 Sec. 95.022. QUALIFICATIONS; TERMS. (a) Each member of the
- 7 board of regents other than the student regent must be a qualified
- 8 voter.
- 9 (b) The board members other than the student regent shall be
- 10 selected from different portions of the state.
- 11 (c) The board members other than the student regent hold
- 12 office for terms of six years, with the terms of two or three
- 13 regents, as applicable, expiring February 1 of odd-numbered years.
- 14 (d) The student regent holds office for a term of one year
- 15 expiring February 1, with the term of the initial student regent
- expiring February 1, 2008.
- SECTION 5. Sections 101.11 and 101.12, Education Code, are
- 18 amended to read as follows:
- 19 Sec. 101.11. BOARD OF REGENTS. (a) The control and
- 20 management of the university is vested in a board of nine regents.
- 21 The board members other than the student regent are appointed by the
- 22 governor with the advice and consent of the senate.
- (b) One of the board members must be a student regent
- 24 serving under Section 51.357.
- Sec. 101.12. TERM OF OFFICE. (a) Members of the board
- other than the student regent hold office for staggered terms of six
- 27 years, with the terms of two or three members, as applicable,

- 1 expiring [on] January 31 of each odd-numbered year.
- 2 (b) The student regent holds office for a term of one year
- 3 expiring February 1, with the term of the initial student regent
- 4 expiring February 1, 2008.
- 5 (c) A [Any] vacancy shall be filled [by appointment] for the
- 6 unexpired portion of the term.
- 7 SECTION 6. Sections 103.02 and 103.03, Education Code, are
- 8 amended to read as follows:
- 9 Sec. 103.02. BOARD OF REGENTS. (a) The organization,
- 10 control, and management of the university is vested in a board of
- 11 nine regents.
- 12 (b) One of the board members must be a student regent
- 13 <u>serving under Section 51.357.</u>
- 14 Sec. 103.03. BOARD MEMBERS: APPOINTMENT, TERMS, OATH. (a)
- 15 Members of the board other than the student regent shall be
- 16 appointed by the governor and confirmed by the senate.
- 17 (b) Members of the board other than the student regent hold
- 18 office for staggered terms of six years.
- (c) The student regent holds office for a term of one year
- 20 expiring February 1, with the term of the initial student regent
- 21 <u>expiring February 1, 2008.</u>
- 22 (d) A [Any] vacancy that occurs on the board shall be filled
- 23 for the unexpired term [by appointment of the governor].
- (e) Each member of the board shall take the constitutional
- 25 oath of office.
- SECTION 7. Sections 105.051 and 105.052, Education Code,
- 27 are amended to read as follows:

- 1 Sec. 105.051. BOARD OF REGENTS. (a) The organization,
- 2 control, and management of the University of North Texas System and
- 3 each component institution of the system is vested in a board of
- 4 nine regents. The board members other than the student regent are
- 5 appointed by the governor and confirmed by the senate.
- 6 (b) One of the board members must be a student regent
- 7 <u>serving under Section 51.357.</u>
- 8 Sec. 105.052. TERM OF OFFICE; REMOVAL; VACANCY. (a) The
- 9 term of office of each regent other than the student regent is six
- 10 years, with the terms of two or three regents, as applicable,
- 11 expiring every two years.
- 12 (b) The student regent holds office for a term of one year
- 13 <u>expiring February 1, with the term of the initial student regent</u>
- 14 expiring February 1, 2008.
- 15 <u>(c) A regent [Members of the board</u>] may be removed from
- office for inefficiency or malfeasance of office.
- 17 (d) A [Any] vacancy that occurs on the board shall be filled
- 18 [by the governor] for the unexpired term.
- 19 SECTION 8. Sections 106.11 and 106.12, Education Code, are
- 20 amended to read as follows:
- Sec. 106.11. BOARD OF REGENTS. (a) The government of the
- 22 university is vested in a board of nine regents. The board members
- 23 other than the student regent are appointed by the governor with the
- 24 advice and consent of the senate [Senate].
- 25 (b) One of the regents must be a student regent serving
- under Section 51.357.
- Sec. 106.12. TERMS OF OFFICE. (a) Regents appointed under

- 1 <u>Section 106.11(a)</u> [<u>Members of the board</u>] hold office for staggered
- 2 terms of six years, with the terms of two or three regents, as
- 3 <u>applicable</u>, [directors] expiring [on] February 1 of odd-numbered
- 4 years.
- 5 (b) The student regent holds office for a term of one year
- 6 expiring February 1, with the term of the initial student regent
- 7 <u>expiring February 1, 2008.</u>
- 8 SECTION 9. Section 107.21, Education Code, is amended to
- 9 read as follows:
- Sec. 107.21. BOARD OF REGENTS. (a) The board of regents of
- 11 the university is composed of nine persons. The board members other
- 12 than the student regent are [, four of whom shall be women,]
- 13 appointed by the governor with the advice and consent of the senate.
- 14 Four of the regents must be women.
- (b) One of the regents must be a student regent serving
- 16 <u>under Section 51.357.</u>
- 17 (c) Each regent other than the student regent must [Each
- 18 member of the board shall] be a qualified voter.
- 19 <u>(d) The regents [; and the members</u>] shall be selected from
- 20 different portions of the state.
- 21 (e) Regents appointed under Subsection (a) [The members]
- 22 hold office for staggered terms of six years, with the terms of two
- 23 <u>or</u> three <u>regents</u>, as applicable, expiring February 1 of
- 24 odd-numbered years.
- 25 (f) The student regent holds office for a term of one year
- 26 expiring February 1, with the term of the initial student regent
- 27 expiring February 1, 2008.

- 1 SECTION 10. Sections 109.21 and 109.22, Education Code, are
- 2 amended to read as follows:
- 3 Sec. 109.21. BOARD OF REGENTS. (a) The government,
- 4 control, and direction of the policies of the university are vested
- 5 in a board of nine regents. The board members other than the
- 6 <u>student regent are</u> [, who shall be] appointed by the governor with
- 7 the advice and consent of the senate.
- 8 (b) One of the regents must be a student regent serving
- 9 under Section 51.357.
- 10 Sec. 109.22. BOARD MEMBERS: TERMS, VACANCIES. (a) Except
- 11 for the initial appointees, regents appointed under Section
- 12 109.21(a) [members] hold office for [of] terms of six years
- 13 expiring [on] January 31 of odd-numbered years[. In making the
- 14 initial appointments, the governor shall designate three for terms
- 15 expiring in 1971, three for terms expiring in 1973, and three for
- 16 terms expiring in 1975].
- 17 (b) The student regent holds office for a term of one year
- 18 expiring February 1, with the term of the initial student regent
- 19 expiring February 1, 2008.
- 20 (c) A [Any] vacancy that occurs on the board shall be filled
- 21 for the unexpired portion of the term [by appointment by the
- 22 governor with the advice and consent of the senate].
- SECTION 11. Section 111.12, Education Code, is amended to
- 24 read as follows:
- Sec. 111.12. APPOINTMENTS TO BOARD; TERMS. (a) The regents
- other than the student regent [Members of the board] are appointed
- 27 by the governor with the advice and consent of the senate.

- 1 (b) One of the regents must be a student regent serving
- 2 under Section 51.357.
- 3 (c) The term of office of each regent appointed under
- 4 Subsection (a) shall be six years, except that in making the first
- 5 appointments the governor shall appoint three members for six
- 6 years, three members for four years, and three members for two
- 7 years.
- 8 <u>(d) The student regent holds office for a term of one year</u>
- 9 expiring February 1, with the term of the initial student regent
- 10 <u>expiring February 1, 2008.</u>
- 11 (e) A [Any] vacancy that occurs on the board shall be filled
- 12 for the unexpired term [by appointment of the governor].
- 13 SECTION 12. The initial term of a student regent designate
- 14 selected for a state university system under Section 51.355,
- 15 Education Code, as added by this Act, or for a state university
- under Section 51.356, Education Code, as added by this Act, expires
- 17 February 1, 2007. The appropriate student governments, system
- 18 regent nominating committees, and boards of regents shall take the
- 19 actions required by Sections 51.355 and 51.356, Education Code, as
- 20 added by this Act, as soon as practicable after this Act takes
- 21 effect to select a student regent designate for each state
- 22 university or state university system for that initial term.
- 23 SECTION 13. The initial term of a student regent on a board
- of regents of a state university or state university system begins
- 25 on the expiration of the initial term of the student regent
- 26 designate serving on that board.
- 27 SECTION 14. Of the terms on the board of regents of a state

- 1 university or state university system that expire February 1, 2007,
- 2 one of the terms is filled by the initial student regent as provided
- 3 by Section 51.357, Education Code, as added by this Act, and two of
- 4 the terms shall be filled for six-year terms as provided by law.
- 5 SECTION 15. This Act does not affect the term of a member of
- 6 a board of regents of a state university or state university system
- 7 serving on the effective date of this Act.
- 8 SECTION 16. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
