## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

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- 2 relating to the regulation of firefighters and fire departments by
- 3 the Texas Commission on Fire Protection.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 419.0082, Government Code, is amended by
- 6 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 7 (d) Notwithstanding other provisions of this section, the
- 8 commission may, without review by an advisory committee, make
- 9 nonsubstantive clerical changes to a rule.
- SECTION 2. Section 419.0322, Government Code, is amended to
- 11 read as follows:
- 12 Sec. 419.0322. CATEGORIES AND DESIGNATION OF PERSONS
- 13 PERFORMING FIRE PROTECTION DUTIES. (a) Each person who is
- 14 assigned by a fire department to perform one or more duties listed
- under Section 419.021(3)(C)  $[\frac{419.021(a)(3)(B)}{2}]$  must be:
- 16 (1) fire protection personnel;
- 17 (2) a part-time fire protection employee; or
- 18 (3) a volunteer or other auxiliary fire fighter.
- 19 (b) Each fire department shall designate each person who is
- 20 assigned by the department to perform one or more duties listed
- 21 under Section 419.021(3)(C) [419.021(a)(3)(B)] as fire protection
- 22 personnel, a part-time fire protection employee, or a volunteer or
- 23 auxiliary fire fighter, but a department may not designate the same
- 24 person under more than one category under this section. The

- 1 designation shall be made on the records of the department and the
- 2 designation shall be made available for inspection by the
- 3 commission or sent to the commission on request.
- 4 (c) A fire department may not compensate, reimburse, or
- 5 provide benefits to a person the department has designated as a
- 6 volunteer or other auxiliary fire fighter to the extent that the
- 7 person would be considered fully paid <u>fire protection personnel</u>
- 8 [under Section 419.021(b)].
- 9 (d) A person designated as a part-time fire protection 10 employee under this section is subject to Section 419.0321.
- 11 SECTION 3. Section 419.063, Government Code, is amended by
- 12 adding Subsection (d) to read as follows:
- 13 (d) The commission may not approve an application if the
- 14 applicant provides fire suppression services and the applicant does
- 15 not routinely and consistently report incidents to the Texas Fire
- 16 Incident Reporting System and participate in the National Incident
- 17 Management System in accordance with the Federal Emergency
- 18 Management Agency timeline. The applicant shall furnish sufficient
- 19 proof of the required reporting to the commission at the time the
- 20 application for a scholarship, grant, loan, or other financial
- 21 assistance is submitted.
- 22 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 23 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 24 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 25 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 26 Act takes effect on the 91st day after the last day of the
- 27 legislative session.
