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violation of Subtitle C, Title 7, Transportation Code, only if the

offense is committed in the county or counties in which the

1 municipality employing the peace officer is located.

- 2 <u>(3)</u> A peace officer making an arrest under this 3 subsection shall as soon as practicable after making the arrest
- 4 notify a law enforcement agency having jurisdiction where the
- 5 arrest was made. The law enforcement agency shall then take custody
- 6 of<u>:</u>
- 7 (A) the person committing the offense and take
- 8 the person before a magistrate in compliance with Article 14.06;
- 9 <u>and</u>
- 10 (B) any property seized during or after the
- 11 arrest as if the property had been seized by a peace officer of that
- 12 law enforcement agency.
- SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
