- 5 SECTION 1. To conform to the repeal of Chapter 484, Health
- and Safety Code, by Chapter 1463 (H.B. No. 2950), Acts of the 77th
- 7 Legislature, Regular Session, 2001, Sections 484.002, 484.003, and
- 8 484.005, Health and Safety Code, as amended by Chapter 459 (H.B. No.
- 9 139), Acts of the 77th Legislature, Regular Session, 2001, are
- 10 repealed.
- 11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 15 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
