S.B. No. 910

A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the repeal of certain obsolete laws defining and
3 regulating nitrous oxide as a volatile chemical.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. To conform to the repeal of Chapter 484, Health
6 and Safety Code, by Chapter 1463 (H.B. No. 2950), Acts of the 77th
7 Legislature, Regular Session, 2001, Sections 484.002, 484.003, and
8 484.005, Health and Safety Code, as amended by Chapter 459 (H.B. No.
9 139), Acts of the 77th Legislature, Regular Session, 2001, are
10 repealed.

11 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
12 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
13 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
14 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
15 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
