1-7 AN ACT

1-8 relating to the repeal of certain obsolete laws defining and
1-9 regulating nitrous oxide as a volatile chemical.

1-10 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-11 SECTION 1. To conform to the repeal of Chapter 484, Health
1-12 and Safety Code, by Chapter 1463 (H.B. No. 2950), Acts of the 77th
1-13 Legislature, Regular Session, 2001, Sections 484.002, 484.003, and
1-14 484.005, Health and Safety Code, as amended by Chapter 459 (H.B. No.
1-15 139), Acts of the 77th Legislature, Regular Session, 2001, are
1-16 repealed.

1-17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-21 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
