A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to the annexation of territory in political subdivisions
3	by certain junior college districts.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter D, Chapter 130, Education Code, is
6	amended by adding Section 130.0712 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 130.0712. ANNEXATION OF TERRITORY BY ELECTION FOR
8	CERTAIN DISTRICTS. (a) Notwithstanding any other provision of
9	this subchapter, a junior college district that includes within its
10	territory all or part of a school district with a student enrollment
11	of more than 170,000 may annex territory by election only as
12	provided by this section. The territory to be annexed must be
13	<pre>located within:</pre>
14	(1) the service area of the junior college district;
15	<u>or</u>
16	(2) a municipality or school district that is partly
17	located within the junior college district.
18	(b) The governing board of the junior college district may
19	order an election on the question of establishing expanded
20	boundaries for the junior college district by annexing all or part
21	of the territory of a municipality or school district described by
22	Subsection (a) if that territory is not currently located in the
23	junior college district. The election shall be held only in the

territory proposed for annexation. The order for the election

1	must:
2	(1) describe the territory to be annexed; and
3	(2) set a date for the election, which must be the next
4	uniform election date that is more than 65 days after the date of
5	the order and that affords enough time to hold the election in the
6	manner provided by law.
7	(c) The governing board shall conduct the election in
8	accordance with the Election Code.
9	(d) Any registered voter residing within the territory
LO	proposed for annexation is entitled to vote at the election.
L1	(e) The ballot shall be printed to provide for voting for or
L2	against the proposition: "Annexation by (with the blank
L3	filled in with the name of the junior college district) of the
L4	following territory for junior college purposes: (with
L5	the blank filled in with a description of the territory proposed for
L6	annexation)."
L7	(f) The proposition is adopted if approved by a majority of
L8	the voters voting at the election. If the proposition is adopted,
L9	the governing board of the district shall enter an order declaring
20	the result of the election and that the territory is annexed for
21	junior college purposes.
22	(g) If the proposition is adopted and the governing board is
23	elected from single-member districts, the governing board in the
24	annexation order entered under Subsection (f) shall assign the new

territory to one or more of the current single-member districts.

The governing board shall divide the territory of the expanded

junior college district into the appropriate number of

- 1 single-member districts before the next election for members of the
 2 governing board.
- (h) If the proposition is not adopted, another election to
 annex the same territory may not be held earlier than one year after
 the date of the election in which the proposition is defeated.

- (i) The annexation of territory to a junior college district under this section and any resulting change in the single-member districts from which members of the governing board are elected does not affect the term of a member of the governing board serving on the date the annexation or redistricting takes effect. The governing board shall provide that each member of the governing board representing a single-member district who is holding office on the date the territory is annexed to the district serves the remainder of the member's term and represents a new single-member district for that term regardless of whether the member resides in the single-member district.
- (j) If the junior college district annexes under this

 section territory comprising all of a municipality or school

 district, the governing board by order may annex for junior college

 purposes any territory later annexed by or added to the

 municipality or school district.
- 22 <u>(k) A junior college district may not annex under this</u>
 23 <u>section territory that is included within the boundaries of another</u>
 24 <u>junior college district.</u>
- 25 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 26 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 27 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this

- 1 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 2 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
