3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subtitle D, Title 16, Property Code, is amended
5	by adding Chapter 431 to read as follows:
6	CHAPTER 431. ENERGY-EFFICIENT BUILDING PROGRAM
7	Sec. 431.001. DEFINITION. In this chapter, "National
8	Housing Act" means Section 203(b), (i), or (k) of the National
9	<pre>Housing Act (12 U.S.C. Sections 1709(b), (i), and (k)).</pre>
10	Sec. 431.002. ENERGY-EFFICIENT BUILDING ACCREDITATION
11	PROGRAM. (a) The commission, in consultation with the Energy
12	Systems Laboratory at the Texas Engineering Experiment Station of
13	The Texas A&M University System, the Texas Commission or
14	Environmental Quality, and an advisory committee appointed by the
15	commission, may establish an energy-efficient building
16	accreditation program for buildings that exceed the building energy
17	performance standards under Section 388.003, Health and Safety
18	Code, by 15 percent or more.
19	(b) If the commission establishes a program under this
20	chapter, the commission, in consultation with the Energy Systems
21	Laboratory, shall update the program on or before December 1 of each
22	even-numbered year using the best available energy-efficient

building practices.

(c) If the commission establishes a program under this

- 1 chapter, the program must include a checklist system to produce an
- 2 energy-efficient building scorecard to help:
- 3 (1) home buyers compare potential homes and, by
- 4 providing a copy of the completed scorecard to a mortgage lender,
- 5 qualify for energy-efficient mortgages under the National Housing
- 6 Act; and
- 7 (2) communities qualify for emissions reduction
- 8 credits by adopting codes that meet or exceed the energy-efficient
- 9 <u>building or energy performance standards established under Chapter</u>
- 10 388, Health and Safety Code.
- 11 Sec. 431.003. PUBLIC INFORMATION PROGRAM. The commission
- 12 may establish a public information program to inform homeowners,
- 13 sellers, buyers, and others regarding energy-efficient building
- 14 ratings.
- Sec. 431.004. MEASUREMENT SYSTEM FOR REDUCTION IN ENERGY
- 16 AND EMISSIONS. If the commission establishes a program under this
- chapter, the Energy Systems Laboratory shall establish a system to
- 18 measure the reduction in energy and emissions produced under the
- 19 energy-efficient building program and report those savings to the
- 20 commission.
- Sec. 431.005. CERTIFICATION FEE. If the commission
- 22 establishes a program under this chapter, the commission may set a
- 23 certification fee sufficient to cover the cost of administering the
- 24 program and pay for any education efforts conducted under this
- 25 chapter.
