## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the election of directors of the Wes-Tex Groundwater

- 3 Conservation District.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Subsection (e), Section 9, Chapter 1473, Acts of
- 6 the 77th Legislature, Regular Session, 2001, is amended to read as
- 7 follows:
- 8 (e) When the boundaries of [At the first election of the
- 9 district after] the county commissioners precincts are redrawn
- 10 under Section 18, Article V, Texas Constitution, a director in
- office on the effective date of the change, or elected or appointed
- 12 before the effective date of the change to a term of office
- beginning on or after the effective date of the change, shall serve
- 14 the term or the remainder of the term in the precinct to which
- 15 elected or appointed even though the change in boundaries places
- 16 the person's residence outside the precinct for which the person
- 17 was elected or appointed [eight new directors shall be elected to
- 18 represent the precincts. The directors elected shall draw lots to
- 19 determine which director from each precinct serves a two-year term
- 20 and which director from each precinct serves a four-year term].
- 21 SECTION 2. Chapter 1473, Acts of the 77th Legislature,
- 22 Regular Session, 2001, is amended by amending Section 11 and adding
- 23 Section 11A to read as follows:
- Sec. 11. ELECTION OF DIRECTORS.  $[\frac{a}{a}]$  On the uniform

- 1 election date prescribed by Section 41.001, Election Code, in
- 2 November [first Saturday in May] of each even-numbered [the second]
- 3 year [after the year in which the district is authorized to be
- 4 created at a confirmation election, an election shall be held in the
- 5 district for the election of:
- 6 [(1) the at-large director and the director from each
- 7 precinct representing an incorporated area of the precinct to serve
- 8 four-year terms; and
- 9 [(2) one director from each precinct representing an
- 10 unincorporated area of the precinct to serve two-year terms.
- 11 [(b) On the first Saturday in May of each subsequent second
- 12 year following the election], the appropriate number of directors
- 13 shall be elected.
- Sec. 11A. ELECTION OF DIRECTORS IN 2006 AND 2008. (a) On
- 15 the uniform election date prescribed by Section 41.001, Election
- 16 Code, in November 2006, an election shall be held in the district
- for the election of the directors from Precincts 2 and 4 to serve
- 18 four-year terms expiring December 1, 2010.
- 19 (b) On the uniform election date prescribed by Section
- 20 41.001, Election Code, in November 2008, an election shall be held
- 21 in the district for the election of the at-large director and the
- 22 directors from Precincts 1 and 3 to serve four-year terms expiring
- 23 December 1, 2012.
- SECTION 3. (a) The terms of the Wes-Tex Groundwater
- 25 Conservation District directors elected from Precincts 2 and 4 and
- serving on the effective date of this Act expire December 1, 2006.
- 27 (b) The term of the Wes-Tex Groundwater Conservation

- 1 District director elected from the district at large and the terms
- of the directors elected from Precincts 1 and 3 who are serving on
- 3 the effective date of this Act expire December 1, 2008.
- 4 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
