1 AN ACT 2 relating to the election of directors of the Wes-Tex Groundwater 3 Conservation District. Δ BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS: SECTION 1. Subsection (e), Section 9, Chapter 1473, Acts of 5 6 the 77th Legislature, Regular Session, 2001, is amended to read as follows: 7 When the boundaries of [At the first election of the 8 (e) district after] the county commissioners precincts are redrawn 9 under Section 18, Article V, Texas Constitution, a director in 10 office on the effective date of the change, or elected or appointed 11 before the effective date of the change to a term of office 12 13 beginning on or after the effective date of the change, shall serve the term or the remainder of the term in the precinct to which 14 15 elected or appointed even though the change in boundaries places the person's residence outside the precinct for which the person 16 was elected or appointed [eight new directors shall be elected to 17 represent the precincts. The directors elected shall draw lots to 18 19 determine which director from each precinct serves a two-year term and which director from each precinct serves a four-year term]. 20 SECTION 2. Chapter 1473, Acts of the 77th Legislature, 21 22 Regular Session, 2001, is amended by amending Section 11 and adding 23 Section 11A to read as follows:

24 Sec. 11. ELECTION OF DIRECTORS. [(a)] On the uniform

23	December 1, 2012.
24	SECTION 3. (a) The terms of the Wes-Tex Groundwater
25	Conservation District directors elected from Precincts 2 and 4 and
26	serving on the effective date of this Act expire December 1, 2006.
27	(b) The term of the Wes-Tex Groundwater Conservation

District director elected from the district at large and the terms of the directors elected from Precincts 1 and 3 who are serving on the effective date of this Act expire December 1, 2008.

4 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 5 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as 6 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 7 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this 8 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
