A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

- 2 relating to the election of directors of the Wes-Tex Groundwater
- 3 Conservation District.
- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. Section 9(e), Chapter 1473, Acts of the 77th
- 6 Legislature, Regular Session, 2001, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 (e) When the boundaries of [At the first election after] the
- 8 county commissioners precincts are redrawn under Section 18,
- 9 Article V, Texas Constitution, <u>a director in office on the</u>
- 10 effective date of the change, or elected or appointed before the
- 11 effective date of the change to a term of office beginning on or
- 12 after the effective date of the change, shall serve the term or the
- 13 remainder of the term in the precinct to which elected or appointed
- even though the change in boundaries places the person's residence
- outside the precinct for which the person was elected or appointed
- 16 [eight new directors shall be elected to represent the precincts.
- 17 The directors elected shall draw lots to determine which director
- 18 from each precinct serves a two-year term and which director from
- 19 each precinct serves a four-year term].
- 20 SECTION 2. Chapter 1473, Acts of the 77th Legislature,
- 21 Regular Session, 2001, is amended by amending Section 11 and adding
- 22 Section 11A to read as follows:
- Sec. 11. ELECTION OF DIRECTORS. $[\frac{a}{a}]$ On the uniform
- 24 election date prescribed by Section 41.001, Election Code, in

- 1 November [first Saturday in May] of each [the first] even-numbered
- 2 year [after the year in which the district is authorized to be
- 3 created at a confirmation election, an election shall be held in the
- 4 district for the election of:
- 5 [(1) the at-large director and the director from each
- 6 precinct representing an incorporated area of the precinct to serve
- 7 four-year terms; and
- 8 [(2) one director from each precinct representing an
- 9 unincorporated area of the precinct to serve two-year terms.
- 10 [(b) On the first Saturday in May of each subsequent second
- 11 year following the election], the appropriate number of directors
- 12 shall be elected.
- Sec. 11A. ELECTION OF DIRECTORS IN 2006 AND 2008. (a) On
- 14 the uniform election date prescribed by Section 41.001, Election
- 15 Code, in November 2006, an election shall be held in the district
- 16 for the election of the directors from Precincts 2 and 4 to serve
- four-year terms expiring December 1, 2010.
- 18 (b) On the uniform election date prescribed by Section
- 19 41.001, Election Code, in November 2008, an election shall be held
- 20 in the district for the election of the at-large director and the
- 21 directors from Precincts 1 and 3 to serve four-year terms expiring
- 22 <u>December 1, 2012.</u>
- 23 SECTION 3. (a) The terms of the Wes-Tex Groundwater
- 24 Conservation District directors elected from Precincts 2 and 4 and
- 25 serving on the effective date of this Act expire December 1, 2006.
- 26 (b) The term of the Wes-Tex Groundwater Conservation
- 27 District director elected from the district at large and the terms

- of the directors elected from Precincts 1 and 3 who are serving on
- 2 the effective date of this Act expire December 1, 2008.
- 3 SECTION 4. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 4 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 5 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 6 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 7 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
