- 5 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 6 SECTION 1. Section 76.011(a), Government Code, is amended

- 9 and rehabilitation of persons in pretrial intervention programs.
- 10 Programs may include testing for controlled substances. A person
- in a pretrial intervention program may be supervised for a period
