## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1 AN ACT

2 relating to the use of private legal counsel by certain hospital

3 districts.

4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

5 SECTION 1. Subsections (b) and (d), Section 281.056, Health

6 and Safety Code, are amended to read as follows:

- 7 (b) The district may employ or contract with private legal
- 8 counsel to represent the district on any legal matter. If the
- 9 district does not employ or contract with private legal counsel on a
- 10 legal matter, the [The] county attorney, district attorney, or
- 11 criminal district attorney, as appropriate, with the duty to
- 12 represent the county in civil matters shall represent the district
- 13 [in all legal matters].
- 14 (d) If the district receives legal services from a county
- 15 attorney, district attorney, or criminal district attorney, the
- 16 [The] district shall contribute sufficient funds to the general
- 17 fund of the county for the account of the budget of the county
- 18 attorney, district attorney, or criminal district attorney, as
- 19 appropriate, to pay all additional salaries and expenses incurred
- 20 by that officer in performing the duties required by the district.
- 21 SECTION 2. Subsection (c), Section 281.056, Health and
- 22 Safety Code, is repealed.
- 23 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 24 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as

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- 1 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 2 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 3 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
