4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter C, Chapter 42, Human Resources Code,
6	is amended by adding Section 42.0422 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 42.0422. STANDARDS FOR CERTAIN DAY-CARE CENTERS. (a)
8	The executive commissioner by rule shall provide for the required
9	modification or waiver of minimum standards or rules generally
10	governing day-care centers to the extent necessary to permit
11	effective and efficient operation by day-care centers that serve
12	children with special care needs, including children with physical
13	or mental disabilities.
14	(b) In modifying or waiving standards as required by
15	Subsection (a), the executive commissioner must consider:
16	(1) additional documentation needed for a child with
17	special care needs, including medical records regarding medication
18	and special health problems;
19	(2) appropriate training requirements for caregivers,
20	including whether any training requirements duplicate training
21	otherwise received by a caregiver and whether additional training
22	is necessary to address medical or other equipment used by a child
23	with special care needs;
24	(3) the developmental age of a child with special care

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1	needs, regardless of the child's biological age, and the
2	appropriateness of increasing the age range for day-care services
3	based on the child's developmental age;
4	(4) the appropriate child per caregiver ratio based on
5	the special care needs of children in the day-care center;
6	(5) the provision of developmental equipment for a
7	child with special care needs;
8	(6) changes in health practices necessary to serve
9	children with special care needs; and
10	(7) safety practices, including fire safety and
11	emergency practices.
12	SECTION 2. Not later than December 1, 2005, the executive
13	commissioner of the Health and Human Services Commission shall
14	adopt the rules required by Section 42.0422, Human Resources Code,
15	as added by this Act.
16	SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.

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
