- SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 28, Education Code, is 5
- 6 amended by adding Section 28.0241 to read as follows:
- Sec. 28.0241. CREDIT FOR ENROLLMENT IN CERTAIN COURSES. 7
- (a) A school district may grant to a student credit toward the 8
- 9 academic course requirements for high school graduation for courses
- the student successfully completes that are offered by an 10
- institution of higher education for course credit toward a degree 11
- 12 offered by the institution.
- (b) This section applies regardless of whether the course 13
- 14 offered by the institution of higher education conforms to the
- essential knowledge and skills identified under Section 28.002 for 15
- a substantially similar course. 16
- SECTION 2. Section 28.0241, Education Code, as added by 17
- this Act, applies beginning with courses completed during the 18
- 2005-2006 school year. 19
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives 20
- 21 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this 22
- 23 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 24 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
