A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to a student union fee at The University of Texas at Tyler.
3	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
4	SECTION 1. Subchapter E, Chapter 54, Education Code, is
5	amended by adding Section 54.5343 to read as follows:
6	Sec. 54.5343. STUDENT UNION FEE; THE UNIVERSITY OF TEXAS AT
7	TYLER. (a) The board of regents of The University of Texas System
8	may levy a student union fee, not to exceed \$100 per student for
9	each regular semester or summer session or more than six weeks and
10	not to exceed \$50 per student for each summer session of six weeks
11	or less, for the sole purpose of financing, constructing,
12	operating, maintaining, and improving a student union building for
13	The University of Texas at Tyler. The fee may not be imposed unless
14	approved by a majority vote of the students participating in a
15	general student election held at the university for that purpose.
16	(b) The student union fee authorized by this section may not
17	be increased more than 10 percent from one academic year to the next
18	unless the increase has been approved by a majority vote of those
19	students participating in a general student election called for
20	that purpose.
21	(c) Such fees shall be deposited to an account known as the
22	University of Texas at Tyler Student Union Fee Account and shall be
23	placed under the control of and subject to the order of the Student
24	Union Advisory Committee. The committee shall annually submit to

- the president of The University of Texas at Tyler a complete and 1 itemized budget to be accompanied by a full and complete report of 2 3 all activities conducted during the past year and all expenditures made incident thereto. The president shall submit the budget to the 4 board of regents as part of the institutional budget. The board of 5 6 regents shall make such changes in the budget as it deems necessary 7 before approving the budget, and shall then levy the fees, within the limits herein fixed, in such amounts as will be sufficient to 8 9 meet the budgetary needs of the student union building.
- 10 (d) A student union fee imposed under this section is not

 11 counted in determining the maximum student services fee that may be

 12 charged under Section 54.503.
- (e) The board of regents may pledge fees levied under this
 section to pay obligations issued pursuant to the revenue financing
 system of The University of Texas System.
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only to fees imposed for a semester or term that begins on or after the effective date of this Act.
- SECTION 3. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives a vote of two-thirds of all members elected to each house, as provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
