A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

1	AN ACT
2	relating to an alternative method of satisfying certain licensing
3	requirements for assisted living facilities.
4	BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
5	SECTION 1. Subchapter B, Chapter 247, Health and Safety
6	Code, is amended by adding Section 247.032 to read as follows:
7	Sec. 247.032. ACCREDITATION SURVEY TO SATISFY INSPECTION
8	REQUIREMENTS. (a) In this section, "accreditation commission"
9	means the Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities
10	or the Joint Commission on Accreditation of Healthcare
11	Organizations.
12	(b) The department shall accept an accreditation survey
13	from an accreditation commission for an assisted living facility
14	instead of an inspection under Section 247.023 or an annual
15	inspection or survey conducted under the authority of Section
16	247.027, but only if:
17	(1) the accreditation commission's standards meet or
18	exceed the requirements for licensing of the executive commissioner
19	of the Health and Human Services Commission for an assisted living
20	facility;
21	(2) the accreditation commission maintains an
22	inspection or survey program that, for each assisted living
23	facility, meets the department's applicable minimum standards as
24	confirmed by the executive commissioner of the Health and Human

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1	Services Commission;									
2	(3) the accreditation commission conducts an on-site									
3	inspection or survey of the facility at least as often as required									
4	by Section 247.023 or 247.027 and in accordance with the									
5	department's minimum standards;									
6	(4) the assisted living facility submits to the									
7	department a copy of its required accreditation reports to the									
8	accreditation commission in addition to the application, the fee,									
9	and any report required for renewal of a license;									
10	(5) the inspection or survey results are available for									
11	public inspection to the same extent that the results of an									
12	investigation or survey conducted under Section 247.023 or 247.027									
13	are available for public inspection; and									
14	(6) the department ensures that the accreditation									
15	commission has taken reasonable precautions to protect the									
16	confidentiality of personally identifiable information concerning									
17	the residents of the assisted living facility.									
18	(c) The department shall coordinate its licensing									
19	activities with each of the accreditation commissions.									
20	(d) Except as specifically provided by this section, this									
21	section does not limit the department in performing any power or									
22	duty under this chapter or inspection authorized by Section									
23	247.027, including taking appropriate action relating to an									
24	assisted living facility, such as suspending or revoking a license,									
25	investigating an allegation of abuse, exploitation, or neglect or									
26	another complaint, assessing an administrative penalty, or closing									
27	the facility.
