- 2 relating to noxious and invasive plants; providing a criminal

- 4 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:
- 5 SECTION 1. The heading to Subchapter D, Chapter 71,
- 6 Agriculture Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 7 SUBCHAPTER D. NOXIOUS AND INVASIVE PLANTS
- 8 SECTION 2. Subsection (a), Section 71.151, Agriculture
- 9 Code, is amended to read as follows:
- 10 (a) The department by rule shall publish a list of noxious
- 11 and invasive plant species that have serious potential to cause
- 12 economic or ecological harm to the state. The department may
- 13 publish lists of noxious <u>and invasive</u> plant species organized by
- 14 region.
- 15 SECTION 3. Section 71.152, Agriculture Code, is amended to
- 16 read as follows:
- 17 Sec. 71.152. NOXIOUS OR INVASIVE PLANT SALE, DISTRIBUTION,
- OR IMPORTATION PROHIBITED. (a) A person commits an offense if the
- 19 person sells, distributes, or imports into the state a noxious or
- 20 invasive plant species included on the department's list described
- 21 under Section 71.151.
- (b) An offense under this section is a Class C misdemeanor.
- (c) A person commits a separate offense for each noxious or
- invasive plant item or unit sold, distributed, or imported.

- 1 SECTION 4. Subchapter D, Chapter 71, Agriculture Code, is
- 2 amended by adding Section 71.153 to read as follows:
- 3 Sec. 71.153. LOCAL REGULATION. (a) A political
- 4 subdivision may not adopt an ordinance or rule that restricts the
- 5 planting, sale, or distribution of noxious or invasive plant
- 6 species.
- 7 (b) This section does not limit the preparation and
- 8 <u>distribution of educational materials relating to plants of local</u>
- 9 <u>concern.</u>
- 10 SECTION 5. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
