The department may publish lists of noxious and invasive plant species organized by 13 14 region. SECTION 3. Section 71.152, Agriculture Code, is amended to 15 read as follows: 16 Sec. 71.152. NOXIOUS OR INVASIVE PLANT SALE, DISTRIBUTION, 17 18 OR IMPORTATION PROHIBITED. (a) A person commits an offense if the person sells, distributes, or imports into the state a noxious or 19 invasive plant species included on the department's list described 20 under Section 71.151. 21 22 An offense under this section is a Class C misdemeanor. (b) 23 (c) A person commits a separate offense for each noxious or 24 invasive plant item or unit sold, distributed, or imported.
