## A BILL TO BE ENTITLED

| 4  | BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:            |
| 5  | SECTION 1. Chapter 485, Government Code, is amended by             |
| 6  | adding Section 485.008 to read as follows:                         |
| 7  | Sec. 485.008. TEXAS MUSIC HISTORY TOUR. (a) The office             |
| 8  | shall develop a Texas Music History Tour program to promote and    |
| 9  | preserve Texas music history.                                      |
| 10 | (b) The program, at a minimum, shall include:                      |
| 11 | (1) designation of locations or organizations that are             |
| 12 | historically significant to this state's musical heritage;         |
| 13 | (2) adoption of an icon, symbol, or other identifying              |
| 14 | device to represent a designation under this section;              |
| 15 | (3) the use of the icon, symbol, or other identifying              |
| 16 | device in promoting tourism around this state by the office and at |
| 17 | locations and by organizations designated under this section; and  |
| 18 | (4) the development of itineraries and maps to guide               |
| 19 | tourists to locations or organizations designated under this       |
| 20 | section.   |
| 21 | (c) The office shall adopt:  |
| 22 | (1) eligibility criteria for a designation under this              |
| 23 | section; and   |
| 24 | (2) procedures to administer the program created under             |

- 1 this section.
- 2 (d) The office shall enter into a memorandum of
- 3 understanding with the Texas Commission on the Arts, the Texas
- 4 Historical Commission, and the Texas Department of Transportation
- 5 to implement this section.
- 6 (e) The office may solicit and accept gifts, grants, and
- 7 other donations from any source to implement this section.
- 8 (f) The office is not required to develop or implement the
- 9 program under this section unless a grant or donation of private
- 10 funds is made to the office to cover the cost of the development and
- 11 <u>implementation of the program.</u>
- 12 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
