1-8 relating to continuing education courses for a county treasurer.

1-9 BE IT ENACTED BY THE LEGISLATURE OF THE STATE OF TEXAS:

1-10 SECTION 1. Subsection (c), Section 83.003, Local Government
1-11 Code, is amended to read as follows:

1-12 (c) The introductory course required by Subsection (a) and
1-13 ~~[at least 10 hours of]~~ the continuing education required by
1-14 Subsection (b) must be sponsored or cosponsored by ~~[taken at]~~ an
1-15 accredited public institution of higher education. ~~[The remaining~~
1-16 ~~required classroom hours, wherever taken, must be certified by an~~
1-17 ~~accredited public institution of higher education.]~~

1-18 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
1-19 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
1-20 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
1-21 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
1-22 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
