- SECTION 1. Subsections (a) and (c), Section 83.004, Local Government Code, are amended to read as follows:

 8 and to take the official oath on or before assuming the office
 9 [within 20 days after the date the certificate of election is

received], the county judge may [shall] declare the office vacant.

- 11 (c) A vacancy in the office of county treasurer shall be 12 filled as provided by Section 87.041. The person appointed to fill 13 the vacancy shall, on or before entering upon the discharge of the 14 duties of office [and within 20 days after the date notice of the 15 appointment is received], take the official oath and obtain the 16 same surety bond as required by Section 83.002(a) for an elected
- SECTION 2. Subsection (b), Section 83.004, Local Government Code, is repealed.
- 20 SECTION 3. The change in law made by this Act:
