- 1 (b) The treasurer must take and subscribe the official oath, 2 which must be endorsed on the bond. The bond and the oath shall be 3 recorded in the county clerk's office. The commissioners court may, at any time, require the treasurer to obtain a new or 4 5 additional bond if the court considers the existing bond insufficient or doubtful. The bond may not exceed the maximum 6 7 amount provided by Subsection (a).
 The bond must be acquired within 20 days after the date notice of the requirement has been given by 8 9 the commissioners court. The failure of a treasurer to obtain a bond required by this subsection subjects the treasurer to removal 10 under Section 83.004. 11
- SECTION 2. The change in law made by this Act applies only to a county treasurer whose term begins on or after the effective date of this Act.
- 15 SECTION 3. This Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
