- 5 SECTION 1. Subchapter G, Chapter 13, Water Code, is amended
- 6 by adding Section 13.258 to read as follows:
- 7 Sec. 13.258. EMINENT DOMAIN. (a) A water and sewer
- 8 utility that is operating pursuant to a valid certificate of
- 9 convenience and necessity may acquire by condemnation any easements
- 10 or lesser property interests reasonably necessary to comply with
- 11 federal and state regulations.

- 12 (b) The right of eminent domain shall be exercised in the
- manner provided by Chapter 21, Property Code.
- 14 (c) The power of eminent domain may not be used for the
- 15 condemnation of land for the purpose of acquiring rights to
- 16 underground water or of water or water rights.
- 17 SECTION 2. This Act takes effect immediately if it receives
- 18 a vote of two-thirds of all the members elected to each house, as
- 19 provided by Section 39, Article III, Texas Constitution. If this
- 20 Act does not receive the vote necessary for immediate effect, this
- 21 Act takes effect September 1, 2005.
